Meeting Minutes: Discussion of what fundraiser to move forward with for 2024-2025 school year. June 7th is national donut day. June 6th is student appreciation day. we could do the donut thing around that day.

### School Board Update - Adrian Newton (traveling for Destination Imagination)

- On behalf of the school board, I would like to recognize and thank the PTA for the
  awesome staff appreciation week. Each year, your organization seems to outdo
  yourselves and it brings so much joy to the school. We appreciate what you do
  for our teachers not only during appreciation week but also during the school
  year.
- The school board met on Tuesday, May 14. We reviewed updated budget data, as our school is still in operation, budget numbers tend to fluctuate. As a review:
  - We need to borrow \$645,787 from next year's budget
  - During the April school board meeting, we were able to bring that number down to \$223,437 by cutting a number of line items that did not affect the day-to-day education of students.
  - During the May school board meeting, we cut an additional \$94,000 by sharing a high school bus with Candia. This sharing does not affect the rider experience for students who are assigned to this bus.
  - As of our last meeting, we still need to borrow \$129,000 from next year's budget. No further action was taken at the May meeting to bring this number down, knowing that we have some time to look at how different cuts will affect students.
  - As of right now, we plan to have the same staffing numbers as this year.
  - As of right now, we plan to NOT have funding interruptions to sports and extracurricular activities.
- The school board was also presented with a comprehensive preschool plan for the 2024-2025 school year. This plan was approved by the school board and next year we will have a preschool classroom, changing our school from a K-8 school to a Pre-K-8 school. Our administrative team has been working hard on this plan and we are excited to bring our youngest learners into the building.
- Also during the May meeting, the school board was updated on the progress of AVS's strategic plan. Many things have happened this school year that are part of our strategic plan. One being the onboarding, training and planning of project based learning and work on new work study practices that mirror what we think is important to all learners.
